The Glen Endoscopy Center is an independent ambulatory care facility. The center is not directly affiliated with any of the physician groups who use our center. Therefore, we do not have access to any patient records outside of our facility.

You will receive a courtesy call to confirm your appointment time the day before your procedure (call for Monday appointments will happen on Friday). We will leave a detailed voicemail message if we are unable to speak to you directly.

Arrival:

Please arrive to our center 45 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment time. Admission will include reviewing your medical history, vital signs, IV placement and meeting with the anesthesia team.

Please bring your photo ID, insurance card and completed paperwork which can be found on our website glenendo.com or through your physician's office.

Transportation after your procedure:

Patients will need a family member or friend to drive them home after their procedure due to anesthesia being administered. **If a patient does not have a ride home, we will be unable to do the procedure.** Taking an Uber is acceptable only with an accompanying family member or friend.

Prep for procedure:

Prep solution is obtained through your physician's office. Questions regarding your prep should be directed to your physician as each doctor has their own instructions. Patients must complete the entire prep (2 doses) at least 3 hours prior to the procedure time.

No liquids 3 hours prior to procedure time.

Covid Requirements:

Due to the Covid 19 pandemic, we require patients to be fully vaccinated or have a negative Covid PCR test (rapid tests are not acceptable). Please bring a hard copy of your results with you to the center. If you have tested positive for Covid 19 within the past 4-6 weeks, we will need to have anesthesia clear you for the procedure prior to your scheduled date.

Medical limitations:

We do not accept patients who are currently receiving dialysis, use oxygen at home, have a cardiac defibrillator or have had a stroke within the last 9 months.
